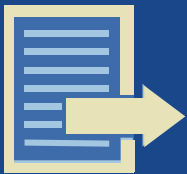
Substance: What are the critical issues and information?

OUR IMPACTS

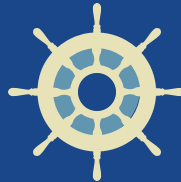
